

FAQ's for Comprehensive Health Services job opportunity

- **I meet the other requirements, but I am not Red Cross certified. How do I get the certification?**
 - The Red Cross always needs volunteers, and will gladly accept new volunteers. Classes are available via their website: <http://www.redcross.org/> under the link for "Get trained". If you are not intending to become a regular Red Cross volunteer, please do not seek their training solely for this position.
- **I want to mail my resume to Paige Valdiserri, but her address wasn't included. How do I get the address?**
 - An email address was provided. All materials should be submitted to behavioralhealth@chsmedical.com. Faxed and mailed resumes are not being accepted.
- **I don't know how to email a resume. Can I still apply?**
 - Most copy and office shops (like Kinko's) can scan and email documents for you.
- **I have questions. Is there a phone number I can call?**
 - No. Because of the large volume of responses, responses must be by email only.
- **I'd like to know more specifics about the job. How can I get more details?**
 - The announcement has all of the key points. If you meet the criteria and are selected for the disaster teams, more information will be provided during the hiring process itself.
- **When will I be notified if I am being accepted?**
 - Applicants who are being accepted will be notified as soon as feasible. Due to the hundreds of responses, applicants who are not accepted may not receive a response. We apologize in advance.
- **If I am hired for a disaster team, should I resign my current job and give 2 weeks notice?**
 - No! As it states in the description, the disaster teams are on stand by only, and generally for a week at a time. These positions are not full time employment.
- **I was denied for a position on a disaster team, but I feel as though I meet the qualifications. Why was I turned down?**
 - Hundreds of applications have been received for approximately 50 positions. As a result, many qualified individuals have not been hired.
